The second season will focus on delivery of supplies to oil drilling sites in the Inuvik region, along the rugged Arctic coast.

"During the first season, our products proved to be steadfast and dependable, which is essential for survival in such brutal conditions," says the company's eastern regional sales director, Tony White, who has first-hand ice road experience thanks to a production location visit earlier this year to introduce drivers to Kinedyne's latest products.
